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General Considerations

Performance outcomes are intended to be calculated for all persons served that meet the inclusion criteria for each measure. This means that an individual served must have received a service in a specified treatment setting (e.g., 1100.06 - Ambulatory – Intensive outpatient), under a subcontract that includes the particular measure (e.g., Adults Employed within 30 days Prior to Discharge). Presently the first part of the criteria can be evaluated as all treatment services have an identified treatment setting. The second criteria of limiting the measurement to specific subcontracts is not part of this document as the business rules of associating services to subcontracts are undergoing substantive changes to account for Project Codes and other situations that vary from the standard service delivery model described in 65E-14.021 Schedule of Covered Services.

Submitting Entities are strongly encouraged to conduct quality review of their provider submitted data prior to submitting data into the Financial And Services Accountability Management System (FASAMS). The quality reviews should help identify situations where there are low data set sizes which can affect performance. For example, if 100 persons are discharged from an ME system of care there may be only 50 persons that meet the inclusion criteria for a particular measure (e.g., employment measures do not include persons in institutional care). Identifying how the data funnels down from a full cohort to a smaller data set may be vital to explaining performance variations.

- had been discharged (non-transfer) from a Civil State Mental Health Facility within the prior 180 days where

- Competency Status at Discharge is
 - 5200.1 - The individual is not under the jurisdiction of the court and is not involved in criminal justice system

AND

- Legal Status at Discharge is one of the following:
 - 4900.1 – Voluntary-self
 - 4900.3 – Involuntary-Civil

- Denominator – distinct count of persons discharged from a Civil State Mental Health Treatment Facility where
- Competency Status at Discharge is
 - 5200.1 - The individual is not under the jurisdiction of the court and is not involved in criminal justice system

AND

- Legal Status at Discharge is one of the following:
 - 4900.1 – Voluntary-self
 - 4900.3 – Involuntary-Civil

AND

- Discharge date is 180 days prior to the reporting period.

Persons Admitted to a Forensic State Mental Health Facility within 180 Days of Discharge

- Numerator - distinct count of persons admitted to a Forensic State Mental Health Treatment Facility where
- Competency Status at Admission is one of the following:
 - 5200.2 - The individual is deemed by the court to be competent to proceed in criminal offenses and is not adjudicated "Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity"
 - 5200.3 - The individual is adjudicated by the court as incompetent to proceed (ITP) at a material stage of a criminal proceeding
 - 5200.4 - The individual is adjudicated by the court as "Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity" on criminal charges

AND

- Legal Status at Admission is
 - 4900.4 – Involuntary - Criminal

AND

- had been discharged (non-transfer) from a Forensic State Mental Health Facility within the prior 180 days where
- Competency Status at Discharge is one of the following:
 - 5200.2 - The individual is deemed by the court to be competent to proceed in criminal offenses and is not adjudicated "Not Guilty by Reason of Insanity"
 - 5200.3 - The individual is adjudicated by the court as incompetent to proceed (ITP) at a material stage of a criminal proceeding

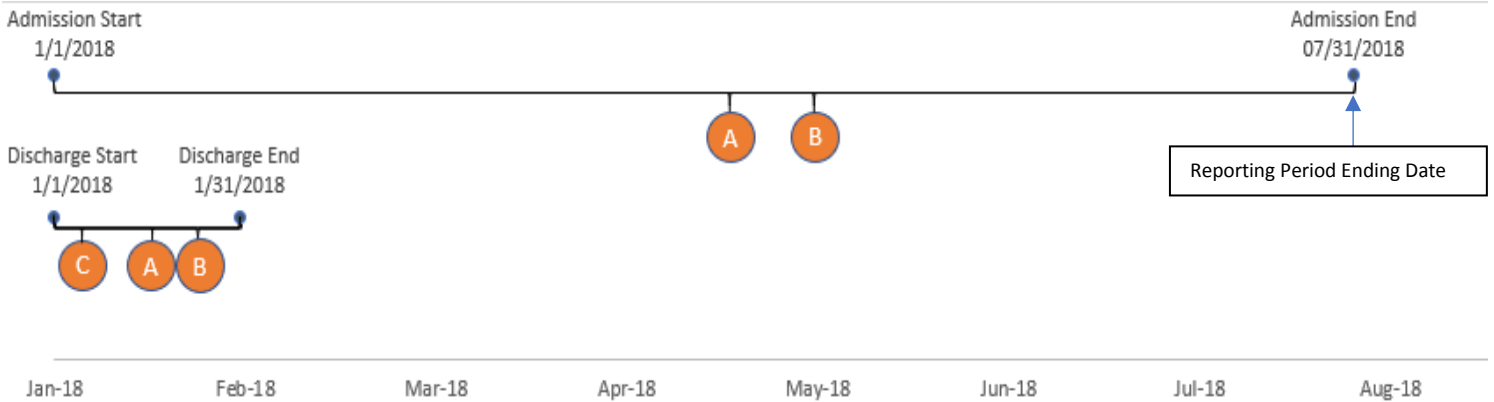

Measure Example – State Hospital Readmissions within 180 Days



In the above example, the reporting period is for July 2018. To capture the individuals that had a readmission in July we would pull all the discharges that occurred 180 days prior to the end of the reporting Period. In this example there are 3 individuals (A, B, C) who were Discharged in January 2018. Of those 3 individuals 2 were readmitted within 180 Days (A, B).

The Denominator is the number of Discharges (3) and numerator the number of those discharges with a Readmission within 180 Days (2).

Performance for this measure at the State level would be 67% for July 2018.
