Kinship Services Network provides relative caregivers with a whole new world of support.

Families receive a thorough in-home assessment to determine family support needs.

The Family Support Coordinator works with the family to link to the services they need such as:

- Public Benefits Application Assistance
- Counseling / Therapy
- Legal Services
- Access to Medical Care
- Mentoring
- Respite Assistance
- Academic Tutoring / Support
- Social / Recreational Activities
- Neighborhood Support
- Transportation
- Vocational Support
- Substance Abuse Treatment

WHO?

Any Relative Caregiver may participate in the program. A Relative Caregiver may be a grandparent, aunt or uncle, sibling, or even a cousin - any relative caring full-time for a child.
