Get Ready for FSFN Enhancements - Child Placement Agreement and

Data Reporting

PURPOSE: The purpose of this memorandum is to update all stakeholders on the status of the upcoming Florida Safe Families Network (FSFN) enhancements to the Child Placement Agreement and Case Assessment Details universe. These changes, scheduled to be implemented on May 12, 2017, will significantly enhance Case Management functionality. Each lead agency will design local training to support its implementation plan for the Placement operating procedure (CFOP 170-11, Chapter 4, http://centerforchildwelfare.fmhi.usf.edu/kb/DCF Pol/CFOP 170/CFOP170-11.pdf).

BACKGROUND: This is the fifth release of enhancements for the "Strengthening Child Safety through Technology" project being implemented during the 2016-17 state fiscal year. Design sessions have been completed, and User Acceptance Testing began on April 24, 2017. The testing is slated to conclude on May 5, 2017.

The functionality enhancements included in this release are:

- New Child Placement Agreement to support the creation and management of care precautions and behavior management plans for children in out-of-home care.
- New Case Assessment Details universe to make data related to the Child Welfare Practice Model readily available to the community-based care lead agencies for reporting and analysis.
