SCOPE

INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS

Business Statement

DCF and the end users of FASAMS require failed delete jobs to display as a warning and not errors.

Scope Definition

- Update FASAMS job processor where failed deletion attempts are flagged as a warning rather than an error

Assumptions, Constraints, Dependencies

- **Note:** Previous failed records with the error message "Cannot find entity to delete" will not be removed from the JobError table as a part of this enhancement.
 - DCF can request those errors be manually deleted which will require a slight increase to the final estimate.

EXISTING FUNCTIONALITY

- Currently in FASAMS an error is generated when the user attempts to delete a record that either does not exist or previously deleted. Error message when this occurs is *"Cannot find entity to delete"*

PROPOSED FUNCTIONALITY

- After the deployment of this enhancement, FASAMS will generate a warning when the user attempts to delete a record that does not exist or was previously deleted
