INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS

Business Statement

DCF is requesting a single (1) SFTP and Web Services account set up for each of the following Managing Entities:

- Lutheran Services Florida
- Carisk Partners
- Five Points

* A service account for SFTP and Web Services will also be set up to be utilized by DCF stakeholders and FEI staff members.

Scope Definition

FEI will create a single (1) SFTP and Web Services account for each of the above Managing Entities. A service account for SFTP and Web Services will also be set up and utilized by DCF stakeholders and FEI staff members.



Assumptions, Constraints, Dependencies

- DCF Users with "DCF Admin Role" will be able to create system accounts
- Multifactor Authentication (OKTA) will not be utilized for SFTP and Web Services
- Log in process thru FASAMS portal will remain the same
 - \circ $\,$ All existing users with FASAMS portal access will remain the same
 - Log in process will continue to be via OKTA Multifactor Authentication
- Each service account will need a unique email address associated with it
 - Please note: Email address will need to be set up in advance
- DCF and each Managing Entity will need access to SFTP and Web Services application
 - Ex: Filezilla, MuleSoft, etc.
- Each service account will either be granted access to SFTP or Web Services or both
- Any changes with assumptions, constraints and dependencies shall be discussed with DCF

EXISTING FUNCTIONALITY

- SFTP: Users are able to access SFTP via individual username and password.
- Web Services: Previously, authentication was via security server utilizing "X-Auth-Token".

PROPOSED FUNCTIONALITY

- FEI will set up SFTP and Web Services accounts for each Managing Entity including Carisk and FivePoints
 - Each account will be set up as follows:
 - Ex. BBCBC_SvcAcct
 - Each service account will require a unique email address
 - An account can be set up with either SFTP or Web Services or Both
- Web Services will use AWS Congnito to authenticate utilizing a custom authentication header named "Authorization".
