### Review and Approval of April 11, 2025 Meeting Minutes

#### **Commission Update**

Commission Chair Jay Reeve provided a brief update on legislative bills related to the Commission. Chair Reeve also provided information on the upcoming in-person meeting in Orlando at the Florida Children and Families Summit on September 2, 2025. The content for the live meeting was discussed and includes: Subcommittee updates, a legislative analysis and a review of prior recommendations from the Commission. Chair Reeve also informed the subcommittee of an additional in-person meeting that will occur in Tallahassee in late March or early April 2026.

Review of Information Presented to the Dual Diagnosis Subcommittee Heather Allman with the Department of Children and Families-Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health reviewed key take aways from five presentations delivered to the Dual Diagnosis Treatment subcommittee.

Subcommittee Chair Hunschofsky requested clarification on pilot data and agency coordination and emphasized the need for public awareness for behavioral health services.

Subject Matter Expert Julie Smythe agreed to compile a list of programs that the subcommittee should examine for outcomes and where capacity issues may exist.
