Review and Approval of October 8, 2025 Meeting Minutes

A motion was entered to approve the October 8, 2025 minutes. The motion was carried. The minutes were approved with no opposition.

Commission Update

Commission Chair Jay Reeve provided a brief update to the subcommittee.

The next full commission meeting will be held at 9am on January 14, 2026, and the next in-person commission meeting will be held April 9, 2026 in Tallahassee. Final recommendations should be submitted to Aaron Platt by mid to late March 2026. The Commission will vote on final recommendations at the next in-person full Commission meeting in early April 2026. Chair Reeve discussed the draft recommendation emerging from the Strategy and Planning subcommittee. The recommendation is to convene a meeting of health and human services state agency leaders at least annually to elevate and address systemic issues emerging from the regional collaborative meetings.

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Mobile Integrated Healthcare – Community Paramedicine

James Crutchfield, Deputy Director of Public Safety for Mantee County presented on Mobile Integrated Healthcare and Community Paramedicine (MIH-CP). Priority populations for the program include seniors (65+), middle-aged adults, young adults, high utilizers, homeless individuals, socially isolated individuals and individuals with limited healthcare access. MIH-CP programs are in most communities but are underutilized for behavioral health interventions.



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Review of Proposed Subcommittee Recommendations

Subcommittee Chair Hunschofsky reviewed draft recommendations submitted by commission members and subject matter experts. Commissioner Larkin-Skinner discussed the broadness of the recommendations and the need for services to be tailored to the needs of the communities in which the services are provided. Chair Reeve suggested the subcommittee recommendations be more specific and that the broader recommendations be broken down to develop more concrete actionable recommendations.

Aaron Platt will send out the recommendations document for subcommittee members to specific actionable recommendations prior to the January 2026 Dual Diagnosis subcommittee meeting. The next meeting will be scheduled for the first week of January 2026.

Laurie Gerhard stressed the importance of education, communication and training for behavioral health professionals.
