CERTIFIED COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CLINIC (CCBHC) SERVICES

 Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics are nonprofit agencies that provide comprehensive, coordinated, ambulatory mental health and substance use services provided across an individual's life span. Services are provided regardless of an individual's ability to pay, diagnosis, or place of residence.

Senate Bill 2500 (2025) appropriations instructed the Department to establish a CCBHC covered service within its financial rules. This includes implementing a prospective payment system that aligns with federal CCBHC payment guidance.

- Draft rule language has been developed for inclusion into Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C) 65E-14.021 to establish a covered son for CCBHC services.
- The Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (SAMH) has shared draft rule language with stakeholders and behavioral health providers for review and feedback.

CCBHC Next Steps:

- Draft rule language will be reviewed for a rule development workshop.
- A Notice of Rule Development will be published in the Florida Administrative Register.
