SCOPE

INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS

Business Statement

FASAMS user need the ability to cancel a submitted job that is still in Initialized status, the ability to exit out of the Upload popup in the Submission tab, and the ability for a user to remove a file from the upload popup in an incorrect file was selected to make the system more user friendly.

Scope Definition

Add the following to the FASAMS portal functionality:

- the ability to cancel a submitted job that is still in Initialized status
- the ability to exit out of the Upload popup in the Submission tab
- the ability for a user to remove a file from the upload popup if an incorrect file was selected



Currently FASAMS does not have the ability to cancel a submitted job that is still in Initialized status, the ability to exit out of the Upload popup in the Submission tab, nor the ability for a user to remove a file from the upload popup in an incorrect file was selected.

PROPOSED FUNCTIONALITY

The following additions will be added to FASAMS:

- Allow users to cancel a job that is still in the Initialized status
- User can exit out of the Upload popup in the Submission tab
- User can remove a file from the Upload popup in the Submission tab
