SCOPE

INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS

Business Statement

The Encounter interface, which provides Encounter Medicaid information, must be updated to remove leading 0s from Medicaid PINs prior to loading them into the FASAMS system. This is necessary to have the most update to date Encounter information for Medicaid clients. Additionally, FASAMS currently does not process the DENT files that are received through the Encounter interface process. Since FASAMS does not process this information, DCF has decided that these files can be deleted from the FASAMS servers, so they do not use up server space.

Scope Definition

The existing Medicaid PINs in the Client table will be updated to add leading 0s to all PINs that have fewer than 10 characters. All PINs will have 10 characters after this enhancement is complete. The interface processor will be updating to delete the DENT return files received during the Encounter interface.

EXISTING FUNCTIONALITY

The Encounter interface is currently designed to save Medicaid PINs, as well as other Encounter data, directly into FASAMS without transforming the data (aka removing the leading 0s from PINs). The interface also has no function to delete DENT files received from the Encounter interface.

PROPOSED FUNCTIONALITY

Modify the existing Medicaid PINs in the client table to add leading 0s to all PINs with fewer than 10 characters. All Medicaid PINs should be 10 characters after this process runs. Update the Encounter interface process to delete DENT files that are received from AHCA. FASAMS should still receive the files in the interface but they should be deleted once received.
